Champagne & Sparkling

The Queen of the wine world!! Although many sparkling wines are made by the famous méthode traditionnelle they do not have the quality and elegance of the best champagne. A unique and varied blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay with the perfect balance achieved through years of tradition and grape harmony blending.

Champagne Louis Roederer Cuvée Cristal 2007 France 0.75l 8,500,000VND

Ultra-fine persistently soft effervescence with the aromatic elegance and precision of Chardonnay. White fruit, sweet pollen and fine fresh citrus fruit cut by thick pure minerality. The bouquet is rich and sweet and the bite in the mouth is full and creamy, revealing an incredible concentration of juicy fruits: yellow peach, apricot and mango explosion with absolute sensuality.

Champagne Billecart Salmon Brut Rosé France 0.75l 3,250,000VND

This Cuvée unveils a subtle aroma leading to an elegant, delicate bouquet of fine notes of red fruits and zest of citrus fruits. Light and elegant in the mouth finishing fresh with a taste of raspberry.

Champagne Louis Roederer Brut Premier France 0.75l 2,750,000VND

Full and generous with big characteristics of maturity with fruitier and more refreshing notes. The wine has a fresh festive finesse, simple yet strong in structure combined perfectly with richness and length.

Champagne Jacques Picard Brut France 0.75l 1,600,000VND

A creamy and gentle wine without heaviness or an excess of lingering yeasty tones. Brilliant and reflective in the glass with superlative pearls of bubbles that ribbon up within the glass. Aromas are reminiscent of a French Patisserie (think croissant, praline and brioche), creamy white tree fruits and fresh minerals.

Jansz Rosé Méthode Tasmanoise Tasmania, Australia 0.75l 1,400,000VND

Vibrant yet delicate pink hue, fine persistent bead and a suggestion of rose petals in the nose, combine with mousse creaminess and strawberries on the tongue to leave a refreshing mouth - watering finish.

Tommasi Prosecco Filodora Veneto, Italy 0.75l 1,200,000VND

The wine is young, fresh and easy drinking at its most pleasurable. The wine features a light orchard fruit tone, recalling white peaches and pears with bright acidity and light body. It makes a richly fruited, soft, medium bodied white wine redolent of melon and green plum.

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White Wines

Chardonnay

Rich is the word that best both describes Chardonnay and explains its popularity. Its aroma is distinct, yet delicate, difficult to characterize and easier to recognize stuffed full of apples, lemons, peaches or tropical fruits.

Food match: seafood, prawns, oysters, veal & light chicken dishes

Joseph Drouhin Chablis

A dry and fruity wine, easy to drink. Its colour is pale gold with greenish hues. Very fresh aromas reminiscent of citrus (lemon or grapefruit); small pleasant touches of fern or coriander are found as well. On the palate, dry and fruity, with mineral notes. Pleasant and long aftertaste.

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Other White Wine Varieties

Currently there are more than 3500 different grape varieties in over 60 wine producing countries. Many of these are domestic grapes that we can only find in those particular areas. In our selection below we offer a few samples of mainly native produced wines.

Gustave Lorentz (Gewurztraminer) Aromas of roses, tropical fruits and exotic spices. A rich and full mouth-feel and a long, pleasant finish with some lively acidic. Lemon curd, white peach and tangerine notes in this tangy white which shows a hint of grapefruit on the finish. There's a nice interplay of sweet and tart.	Alsace, France	1,350,000VND

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Sauvignon Blanc

The varietal identity of Sauvignon Blanc is typically similar to grass, bell-pepper or grapefruit in nature. New Zealanders liken it to "gooseberry" and most commonly considered fruity. Also known as "Fume Blanc" or Pouilly Fume".

Food match: light seafood, lightly spiced dishes

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Pinot Gris

Pinot Gris or Pinot Grigio is usually delicately fragrant and mildly floral with lightly lemon-citrus flavors. Pinot Gris can be tangy and quite rich with a finish that is round and full bodied. The best examples for Pinot Gris come from Italy and Alsace.

Food match: light pasta dishes, fish, shell fish and salads

Tommasi Le Rosse Clean and spicy with typical hints of tropical fruit. Medium-bodied with a clean, round, soft and a sharp crisp finish. Exquisite peach and pear aromas and a palate that is both dry yet full of soft fleshy fruits.	Veneto, Italy	1,500,000VND

Riesling

Riesling grapes, which originate in Germany's Rhine region, have sweet fruity flavors and aromas of flowers and fruits. Other characteristics of wines made from Riesling grapes include high acidity and petrol notes if aged. The character of a Riesling wine depends heavily on where it is grown because Riesling grapes are very 'terroir expressive

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Red Wines

Cabernet Sauvignon

It's distinctive black-currant aroma can develop bouquet nuances of cedar, violets, leather or cigar box and its typically tannic edge may soften and smooth considerably allowing a degree of bell pepper or weediness to develop over time.

Food match: grilled meats, venison, truffles & meaty stews

Freemark Abbey 2011 Napa Valley, California, USA 2,800,000VND

A century-old winery. This beautiful Cabernet Sauvignon epitomises the Napa quality of power married to finesse. The aromas of dark cherry, red plum and blackberry are integrated with the spicy sweetness of oak, cedar, cinnamon, clove and toast. The body is very full with dark cherry/berry flavors that develop from start to finish.

Château Los Boldos, Vieilles Vignes Rapel Valley, Chile 2,400,000VND

The nose offers intense blackberry notes, spices, mature fruits like cassis and dried plum. Very well balanced. It reveals the complexity of noble oak that adds aromas to vanilla and coffee.

Vinum Stellenbosch, South-Africa 1,200,000VND

Cigar box, blueberry, cherry and delicate spice mingle seamlessly, bridging the lapse between sips. The classic structure of Old World Cabs, with a nod to the warmth of the New World's accessible flavors.

Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot Blends

Château Ferrière, Grand Cru Classé 2005 Margaux, Bordeaux, France 4,300,000VND

Margaux is the richest area in classified Grands Crus Classés estates in Médoc. This shows the quality of the terroir. Château Ferrière has one of the smallest vineyards of all the Grands Crus Classés in 1855. Deep garnet hues and a brilliant red sparkle. With a bright, classic, red berry character, this medium-bodied wine finishes on the crisp side of the red fruit style range

Château Haut-Bages Libéral, Grand Cru Classé 2008 Pauillac, Bordeaux, France 3,500,000VND

Just one small country lane separates this Château and Pauillac's famous "Château Latour". Medium-dark ruby, fruity, bright aromas of red cherry, red berries and flowers. Then light and lively in the mouth, with strawberry, raspberry and smoky dark cherry flavors complicated by hints of white pepper and gunflint.

Château Citran, Cru Bourgeois Médoc, Bordeaux, France 1,900,000VND

A pure and rather elegant taste with dark fruit nose which shows some real class. Presenting an evocative and perhaps even seductive character. The palate, however, is firm and stylish, medium bodied with ripe red fruit.

Château Haut Saint-Brice, St. Emilion Grand Cru Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France 1,850,000VND

The nose is dominated by aromas of ripe, almost jammy fruit - on the palate, the medium - bodied fruitiness comes through with smooth, well integrated tannins, leading to a long, harmonious and remarkably fine finish

Château Haut De Selves Graves, Bordeaux, France 1,500,000VND

A complex nose with notes of candied fruit and vanilla, nicely rounded and supple in the mouth. Very good balance with a long finish

Château Bouteilley Premières Côtes de Bordeaux Bordeaux, France 1,100,000VND

A complex nose with notes of candied fruit and vanilla, nicely rounded and supple in the mouth. Very good balance with a long finish.

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Pinot Noir

The aroma can often be intense with a ripe-grape or black cherry aroma, frequently accented by a pronounced spiciness that suggests cinnamon, saffras or mint. Ripe tomato, mushroom and a fabled barnyard touch are also common descriptors for identifying Pinot Noir. It is full-bodied and rich but not heavy, high in alcohol, yet neither acidic nor tannic, with substantial flavor despite its delicacy.

Food match: grilled salmon, grilled beef, tuna, swordfish, lamb, duck & game

Joseph Drouhin Gevrey-Chambertin 2012 Intensely fruity on the nose, the aromas are reminiscent of black cherry, wild blackberry and liquorice. The woody character is subtle and marries delicately with the other aromas. The tannins blend harmoniously with the natural freshness and "gras" (velvety texture) of the wine. All vintages from Maison Joseph Drouhin are certified "organic" from 2009 onwards	Burgundy, France	3,700,000VND
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Craggy Range - Te Muna Road Vineyard Bright red cherry colour with a crimson hue. Seductive aromas of dark cherry, dried rose petals, thyme and damp earth. Beautifully varietal, elegant and long on the palate. 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Merlot

Merlot has slightly lower natural acidity than Cabernet and generally less astringent, therefore usually a lush mouth-feel. Merlot is by far the most widely planted grape of the entire Bordeaux region and third- behind Carignan and Grenache as the most planted red grape variety in France.

Food match: grilled steaks, game, lamb, duck, dark wine sauces & mushrooms

Château Los Boldos Vieilles Vignes The nose is extremely ripe with dry plum and raspberry. Ripe tannins mixed with vanilla notes in the nose. The palate shows mature plum and raspberry notes. A very complex wine.	Rapel Valley, Chile	2,400,000VND
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Deakin Estate Red Cliffs Coffee and wet forest floor aromas with blackcurrant and cinnamon. These are wild and complex aromas and a precise description is elusive.	Victoria, Australia	1,200,000VND

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Syrah/Shiraz

Syrah is the only grape used to make the famous Rhône wines of the Côte Rôtie and Hermitage but also forms the backbone of most Rhône blends, including Châteauneuf du Pape.

Food match: Asian spiced dishes, light curries, tamarind, cardamom, roasts, lamb, game birds and strong flavour wine sauce

Jim Barry 'Lodge Hill' Clare Valley, Australia 1,700,000VND
Typical Clare Valley old vine Shiraz, a dark succulent, savory wine with fine silky tannins and lots of pepper with a warm oaky finish. Fruity and aromatic floral characters with a nose of limey citrus.

M. Chapoutier Crozes-Hermitage "Les Meysonniers" Rhône Valley, France 1,650,000VND
Deep purple red in colour combining generous and round tasting with a finish of stewed fruits and a hint of vanilla.

Syrah & Blend

Rockford Moppa Spring Barossa Valley, Australia 3,000,000VND
(Shiraz - Grenache – Mourvedre)
Its slightly meaty prune-like aromas of plums, raisins and cinnamon clove spices precede a smooth and gentle finish. On the palate it offers a spicy and slightly herbal flavour reminiscent of dark plums and red berries.

Yalumba Organic Riverland, Australia 1,300,000VND
(Cabernet Sauvignon - Shiraz)
This wine is crimson red and offers aromas of plum and fruit cake combined with savoury notes. Flavours of plum and dark cherries are blended with a hint of spice and subtle oak complexity, delivering a medium weight wine with soft supple tannins and a lingering finish.

M. Chapoutier Belleruche Côtes-du-Rhône, France 1,200,000VND
(Grenache – Shiraz)
Red fruit aromas boasting loads of Morello cherries in this well structured and complex red. A nice spicy finish for a typical Côtes du Rhône and needless to say an extremely versatile red.

Yalumba Y Series Barossa Valley, Australia 1,200,000VND
(Shiraz - Viognier)
Big in the mouth it quickly gives way to dried apricot and black cherry followed by a spicy floral combination likened to potpourri. White flowers and honeysuckle with hints of apricot nectar.

Malbec

Malbec grapes originated in France and play a big role in the wine production of Argentina. The flavors and aromas of wines made from Malbec grapes include blackberry, cherry, plums, and chocolate. Other characteristics of Malbec wines include inky-black coloring, soft or high tannins, and high acidity.

Alta Vista Terroir Selection Mendoza, Argentina 1,700,000VND
A harmonious selection from the best Malbec Terroirs in Mendoza. This wine has deep purple hues. In the nose, it features spicy aromas with fresh, ripe fruits and animal notes. In the mouth, it shows a fresh attack and great openness as well as soft tannins and a long finish.

Alta Vista Premium Mendoza, Argentina 1,200,000VND
Fleshy and aggressive on the bouquet, this has aromas of wild berries, with leather and dried cheese accents. It feels full and weighty, with sweet, almost-stewy flavors of blackberry and plum, and supporting notes of vanilla and spice

Pigmentum South-West, France 950,000VND
Powerful aromas on the nose of red and black fruits: raspberry, blackcurrant, blackberry, which continues in the mouth. Ripe tannins are supported by the fruit flavors. A soft and easy wine

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Grenache

Grenache grapes originated in Spain where it is called Garnacha, but Grenache is the name by which the grapes and resulting wine are most commonly known. Grenache wines have flavors and aromas of strong fruit, raspberries, and a bit of spice.

Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2012 La Crau, Rhône Valley, France 3,900,000VND
Rock-solid, with a hefty core of fig, blackberry and black cherry fruit, wrapped in chestnut and tobacco leaf notes and carrying through a lavender- and tar-framed finish. Dense and grippy, showing a slightly old-school shading

M. Chapoutier La Bernardine, Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rhône Valley, France 2.900.000VND
Complex and subtle, blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, cherry, morello cherry

Yalumba Bush Vine Grenache Barossa Valley, Australia 1,650,000VND
A medium depth crimson red, this wine has a generous and bright aroma that opens to a spicy clove lift then moves into hints of white pepper and savoury notes amongst an earthy background

Other Red Wines

Antinori Peppoli Estate Chianti Classico Tuscany, Italy 1,700,000VND
(Sangiovese/ Merlot)
Fruity with hints of currants, plums, blackberries and bare hints of tobacco and vanilla

Arzuaga Pago Florentino Castilla, Spain 1,500,000VND
(Cencibel)
Deep in color, modern style tempranillo. Notes of chocolate, smoke and black fruit on the nose. Full-bodied, velvety smooth and lush with more black fruit and chocolate on the palate. Pago Florentino, is in Parker's list of top 100 wines in Spain. It has won awards in Concurso Viniales International Paris 2009 and Decanter World Wine Awards.

Marqués de Cáceres Crianza Rioja Rioja Alta, Spain 1,500,000VND
(Tempranillo/Garnacha Tinta/Graciano)
Raspberry, dark plum, cinnamon and vanilla

Tommasi Bardolino Classico Veneto, Italy 1,500,000VND
(Corvina Veronese/Rondinella)
Very fruity and fresh with lots of cherry notes

Saumur-Champigny "La roche Saint Vincent" Loire Valley, France 1,300,000VND
(Cabernet Franc)
Soft and smooth Cabernet franc with a long firm finish

The Winery of Good Hope Stellenbosch, South-Africa 900,000VND
(Pinotage)
Red cherries, violets and juicy palate, which finishes with balance length, a touch of minerality and some really funky spice.

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Rosé

Rosé is a type of wine that is neither purely red wine nor purely white wine. It is made from red-skinned grapes with the skins removed from contact with the pressed juice after a short period, rather than left in contact throughout fermentation as with red wine making. As the skins contain much of the strongly flavored tannin and other compounds, this leaves the wine tasting more similar to a white wine.

Domaines Ott – Château de Selle, Rosé Cœur de Grain (Grenache) Pink with ruby highlights. Fine fruity nose, great length, hints of raspberry and redcurrant. Good balance in the mouth, harmonious, very fresh ending with a delightful fruity flavour.	Provence, France	2,100,000VND

Château Coutet, Premier Grand Cru Classé 1995 Thomas Jefferson celebrated Château Coutet as the best Sauternes from Barsac during his ambassadorship to France. Today, Château Coutet stays true to its tradition of distinction and quality by producing the finest Barsac year after year. Great concentration on the nose, with powerful aromas. Piles of botrytis on the palate, which is loaded with quince flavour. A fine, grippy style, with a great presence in the mouth and superb acidity. This wine has a wonderful structure.
